<b>Statement</b>	STSBHN accepts one address for each student whom it serves. When the father, mother, and/or guardian have joint custody of a student, and transportation to/ from the address of the non-custodial parent is provided, the rules of (017) Courtesy Transportation apply.
<b>Procedures</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Since transportation is provided to a student based on a single primary address, the student's alternate address shall be handled in accordance with (017) Courtesy Transportation pertaining to courtesy seats.</li> <li>2. If Joint Custody Transportation is not available, the father, mother, and/or guardian must decide which address is the primary address. Transportation will be provided from that address if it meets all criteria as it is set out in (002) Transportation Eligibility.</li> </ol>
<b>Joint Custody Alternating Each Week</b>	On a permanent basis, when a student resides alternately for one week with his/her father or guardian, and the next week with his/her mother or guardian, transportation services cannot be granted to a second address by STSBHN other than through the availability of courtesy transportation.
<b>Joint Custody During the Same Week</b>	On a permanent basis, when a student resides alternatively for one week with his/her father or guardian, and the next week with his/ her mother or guardian, transportation services cannot be granted to the second address by STSBHN other than through the availability of courtesy transportation.
